### 2010 Project Achievements

- Hosted a Sector Forum to determine needs and priorities of Dufferin's NFP organizations
- Hosted an educational workshop for area Food Banks with Kawartha Food Share



### **Year I Grants**

- Big Brothers/Big Sisters youth diabetes mentoring program
- Caledon Meals on Wheels –extending their SMILE
  exercise program into the Dufferin area
- The Dufferin Parent Support Network –support for a short-term fundraising director
- The Orangeville Food Bank to partner with food banks in Grand Valley, Shelburne and Westminster United Church Food & Milk Cupboard.
- The Alzheimers Society of Dufferin to coordinate volunteer services in the area.
- Up and Out of Homelessness to complete a homelessness prevention framework for Dufferin County.



### 2011 Project Achievements

- Conducted research into needs and options re: Alternative Transportation in Dufferin
- Developed a collaborative funding proposal to pilot an alternative transportation project
- Hosted an information session on funding and community foundations





- The Dufferin Parent Support Network-Environmental Scan Project – to identify parent support needs in Dufferin County
- The Orangeville Food Bank Collaborative Venture – to enable bulk purchasing and Healthy Eating workshops
- Orangeville Curling Club Enabled Curling Program – to purchase equipment to improve accessibility to the curling rink.
- SHIP Supported Housing in Peel "Grow Green" Initiative – a feasibility study around community garden greenhouse





- The Gateway Community Centre General Support – to continue operations while obtaining sustainable funding
- Orangeville Baptist Church Single Mom's
  Day expansion of the existing program
- Hospice Dufferin Strategic Plan for Palliative Care Service Delivery in Dufferin – support for shared vision and plan for the delivery of palliative care services in Dufferin County
