
Three types of grants


 Operating – support specific organizational operations that are in direct alignment with Ministry priorities. An example would be the Newcomer Settlement Program and Community Museum Operating Grant.


- Project support project (non-operational, non-capital) related activities that align directly with Ministry priorities. Examples would be the Healthy Community Fund and the Creative Community Prosperity Fund.
- Capital usually support infrastructure related projects, such as services, roads and facilities.






